We are using a brother to this heifer in our program where he has weaned his second set of calves. We are stacking this heifers mother on both the top and bottom sides of our pedigrees. The Mama's Boy females were highlights at the U2 Dispersal being amongst the highest selling females. This female is no accident she is bred to work. 21N will be entered in Agribition. This prolific cow family is responsible for 136 registered progeny between the dam, granddam and great granddam
